## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 2 and to read as follows: 3 Organ donation; tax deduction. (a) There 4 "§235-5 shall be allowed as a deduction from adjusted gross income the 6 amount, not to exceed \$10,000, for amounts paid or accrued thereon, during the taxable year the organ donation occurred, by 8 an individual taxpayer for expenditures incurred related to 9 donating organs. (b) To qualify for the deduction, the organ donor must be 10 11 living, a full-time resident of the state, and have donated one or more of the donor's organs to another human being for organ 12 13 transplantation. The deduction claimed under this section shall be 14 claimed during the taxable year in which the organ 15

transplantation occurs.

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1	(d) An individual may claim the deduction under this
2	section once and may be claimed for only the following
3	unreimbursed expenses incurred by the claimant and related to
4	the claimant's organ donation:
5	(1) Travel expenses;
6	(2) Lodging expenses; and
7	(3) Lost wages.
8	(e) The director of taxation shall prepare forms as may be
9	necessary to claim a tax deduction under this section, may
10	require proof of the claim for the tax deduction, and may adopt
11	rules pursuant to chapter 91.
12	(f) For the purposes of this section, "organ" means all or
13	part of a liver, pancreas, kidney, intestine, lung, or bone
14	marrow."
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
17	and shall apply to taxable years beginning after December 31,
18	2006.
