A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SCIENCE EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 160, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006,
- 2 appropriated \$2,000,000 for purchasing science textbooks and
- 3 teaching resources. Fifteen complex areas submitted requests
- 4 totaling nearly \$6,000,000.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for science
- 6 textbooks and other teaching resources; provided that schools
- 7 within a complex receiving funds have a K-12 articulated science
- 8 curriculum.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$4,000,000, or so
- 11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, to
- 12 purchase science textbooks and other teaching resources;
- 13 provided that schools within a complex receiving funds have a
- 14 K-12 articulated science curriculum.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 education for the purposes of this Act.
