SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ENVIRONMENTAL COUNCIL TO CREATE AN EXEMPTION IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS FOR STATE AND COUNTY ACTIONS RELATING TO EASEMENTS AND RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

WHEREAS, a recent Hawaii Supreme Court decision and
 developing case law may have the unintended consequence of
 requiring all state and county actions regarding easements and
 right-of-ways to be subject to an environmental assessment; and

6 WHEREAS, the Environmental Council has, under section
7 343-6(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the authority to adopt,
8 amend, or repeal necessary rules pursuant to the environmental
9 assessment process; and

11 WHEREAS, the Environmental Council has, under section 12 343-6(a)(7), Hawaii Revised Statutes, the authority to establish 13 procedures whereby specific types of actions which have minimal 14 or no significant effect on the environment are declared exempt 15 from the environmental assessment process; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Environmental Council is requested to establish by rule, an environmental assessment preparation requirement exemption for state and county actions regarding easements and right-of-ways of five acres of land or less; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Environmental Council, with 26 the assistance of the Office of Environmental Quality Control, 27 submit a report to the Legislature not later than twenty days 28 prior to the convening of the 2009 Regular Session at the 29 actions taken to draft, adopt, and effectuate the exemption by 30 rule requested under this measure; and
