## SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE BUILDING CODE COUNCIL TO EXPEDITIOUSLY ADOPT PROVISIONS IN THE INTERNATIONAL BUILDING CODE, 2006 EDITION, RELATING TO PHYSICAL ASSISTANCE IN EVACUATION FOR RESIDENTS IN ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES OR SIMILAR FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, in considering the needs of Hawaii's elderly, the
 Legislature has recognized the importance of developing a long term care infrastructure plan to ensure public safety while
 supporting aging in place; and

6 WHEREAS, the State Building Code Council, established by
7 Act 82, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, has the responsibility to
8 establish a comprehensive state building code; and

10 WHEREAS, the latest edition of the International Building 11 Code provides building code regulations for assisted living 12 facilities for the evacuation of residents in an emergency; and 13

WHEREAS, to achieve the objective of supporting aging in 14 place, S.B. No. 3187, Regular Session of 2008, proposed to 15 implement the recommendations of the task force convened 16 pursuant to Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 144, S.D. 1, 17 adopted during the Regular Session of 2006, by requiring the 18 State Building Code Council to amend the provisions of the 19 International Building Code relating to assisted living 20 facilities and similar facilities; and 21

23 WHEREAS, S.B. No. 3187, 2008, was deferred by the Senate
24 Committee on Intergovernmental and Military Affairs for
25 consideration of a Resolution instead; and

27 WHEREAS, the reason for the deferral was that the Committee 28 believes that building codes are an administrative matter rather 29 than a statutory enactment; and 30

31 WHEREAS, the building code provisions of S.B. No. 3187 32 would expand Hawaii's capacity for providing long-term care by

allowing residents to preserve their independence while 1 receiving necessary support services in the community; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the State Building Code Council is familiar with 4 and has taken up consideration of the provisions of S.B. No. 5 3187, but has not acted on it yet; and 6 7 WHEREAS, to date, forty-six states have adopted the new 8 9 building code provisions for assisted living facilities, which is necessary for new construction of assisted living facilities 10 and upgrading of existing facilities, both critical to expanding 11 long-term care; now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 14 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, 15 that the State Building Code Council is urged to expeditiously 16 adopt provisions in the International Building Code, 2006 17 edition, relating to physical assistance in evacuation for 18 19 residents in assisted living facilities or similar facilities; 20 and 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Building Code Council 22 report its findings and recommendations to the Legislature no 23 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular 24 25 Session of 2009; and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 27 Resolution be transmitted to the Comptroller, the Executive 28 29 Director of the State Building Code Council, the Governor, and the Mayor of each county. 30 11/ill an 31 32 33 OFFERED BY: un Aaliland 2008-1110 SR SMA-1.doc
