SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO EXPLORE THE FEASIBILITY OF AND TO DEVELOP A PLAN THEREFOR RELOCATING THE KAPAA PUBLIC LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the Kapaa Public Library in East Kauai was built 1 in 1959 and is undersized and deteriorating; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, according to United States Census records, the service area population (Kawaihau) has increased one hundred and 5 eighty-five per cent between 1960 and 2000; however, there has 6 7 been no increase in the library's collection space during that same time period; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, having recognized that the library is undersized for the area and population it serves, discussions for expansion 11 of the library are ongoing; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the recently completed AM Partners 14 study/assessment of the existing facility revealed several 15 zoning, permit, and variance issues that would impede the 16 library's expansion; and 17 18 WHEREAS, for example, the current zoning restricts the 19 library to covering a maximum of ten per cent of its lot, but 20 the current facility and pavement already cover thirty-seven per 21 cent of the lot; hence, expansion is not a viable option at this 22 current site; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the existing library is located adjacent to Kapaa 25 County Beach Park and abuts a new, popular bike/walking path 26 also owned by the County of Kauai; and 27 28 WHEREAS, at least one County Councilmember has indicated an 29 interest in the library property for the purpose of expanding 30 Kapaa County Beach Park and to capitalize on the popularity of 31 the bike/walking path; and 32 33

WHEREAS, in addition, the proximity of the bike/walking 1 path has added to parking issues as some people are using the 2 library parking lot to access the path; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the backdoor of the library is less than fifty yards away from the shoreline and the salt air causes damage to 6 7 the air conditioning and electrical systems, and the area would 8 be at risk in the event of a tsunami; and 9 WHEREAS, the library is located on Kuhio Highway, the 10 island's main thoroughfare, and traffic congestion deters local 11 residents from visiting the library; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the relocation of the library to an area adjacent 14 to the main Kapaa County Park off of Olohena Road would support 15 16 a dramatic expansion and improvement of the park, enhance the community activities now occurring at this inland location, 17 increase accessibility to the library, and facilitate needed 18 updating of the library facilities; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-fourth 21 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2008, 22 that the Department of Education work with the County of Kauai, 23 Kapaa community members, and appropriate state agencies to 24 explore the feasibility of relocating the Kapaa Public Library 25 to an inland location near or adjacent to the Kapaa County 26 Park's sports field and the Army National Guard Facilities, and 27 to develop a plan therefor; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Education is 30 requested to consider incorporating the following into the plan 31 for the new library: 32 33 An expanded technology center and community center 34 (1)facilities for meetings and community gatherings; 35 36 The swapping of county and state lands or some other (2) 37 agreement that provides the County of Kauai the right 38 to use the land under the existing Kapaa Public 39 Library; and 40 41 The design and use of the new library as a potential (3)42 disaster shelter for use during times of emergency; 43 and 44

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 9 Education, the Superintendent of Education, the Mayor of Kauai, 10 members of the Kauai County Council, the State Librarian, and 11 the Kapaa Public Library Branch Manager.
