The purpose of this bill is to further develop the potential of the aquaculture industry in Hawaii by appropriating funds to pay for the increased costs of, and attract federal funding for, statewide technical assistance provided to the aquaculture industry through the University of Hawaii (UH) Sea Grant Extension Service.

The Maui Community College Agriculture Program, Kamehameha Schools Maui Campus, Hawaii Aquaculture Association, Aquatic Innovations, Rain Garden Ornamentals, Pacific Aquaculture and Biotechnology LLC, and a concerned individual testified in support of this bill. - (1) Changing the appropriation to \$1 to encourage further discussion; and
