Your Committee received testimony in support of Kyoko Y. Kimura from the Hawai'i Tourism Authority, Tourism Liaison, Maui Visitors Bureau, Pacific Cancer Foundation, Hawaii Employers Council, Maui Economic Development Board, Inc., Hawai'i Hotel & Lodging Association, Japanese Cultural Society of Maui, Maui Hotel & Lodging Association, and two individuals.

The nominee received a B.A. degree from Kobe Jogakuin University, Master in Translation from the Babel Institute of Communication, Certified Hotel Administrator from the American Hotel and Lodging Association, and GMP from Cornell University School of Hotel Administration. She is currently the President and General Manager of Diamond Hotel Resort & Spa. Ms. Kimura is presently a board member of the Hawaii Hotel Association and was formerly the Board Chairperson of the Maui Hotel Association.
