Your Committee on Human Services and Public Housing, to which was referred S.B. No. 1737 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO ENTERPRISE ZONES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to define "long-term care facilities" and include care in long-term care facilities as part of a service business that may qualify for beneficial treatment within an enterprise zone.

The Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism submitted testimony in support of this measure.

Your Committee finds that there is an increasing demand and need for long-term care facilities. According to the testimony, many hospitals are unable to accept ambulance patients because of the large number of long-term care patients occupying hospital Including long-term care facilities in the list of businesses within the State Enterprise Zone statute that are eligible for seven years of tax credits and exemptions will help to reduce the long-term care facilities' operating costs and hopefully encourage the development of new and the expansion of existing long-term care facilities.

It is your Committee's intent to support the inclusion of care in long-term care facilities as part of a service business that may qualify for beneficial treatment within an enterprise zone. Your Committee has amended this measure by making
