Status SB 2498 Testimony Status	RELATING TO A MAKAHIKI DAY COMMEMORATION. Establishes each November 20th as the Makahiki commemoration day.	AHW, EDT
SB 2915 Testimony	RELATING TO TARO. Creating the taro security and purity task force and appropriating funds for that purpose.	AHW, WAM
SB 3156 Testimony Status	RELATING TO DROUGHT MITIGATION TAX CREDIT. Provides a tax credit equal to 50% of the costs for construction of a new drought mitigation water storage facility, or repair or reconstruction of an existing water storage facility	AHW, EDT/WAM
SB 3209 Testimony Status	RELATING TO TAX CREDITS. Provides a tax credit for qualified agricultural costs incurred to improve farms on land classified as agricultural districts.	AHW, EDT/WAM
