<u>Testimony</u> Transfers jurisdiction of inadvertently discovered native Hawaiian

burial sites from the department of land and natural resources to the appropriate island burial council. Provides sixty days for burial council to make a determination on burial site treatment or removal. Allows state historic preservation officer to make a determination if

council is unable after sixty days.

SB 2644 RELATING TO THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION EDT/AHW

Testimony OFFICER.

Specifies the required qualifications for a state historic preservation officer and adds requirement that notice of the appointment of a state

historic preservation officer be given to the legislature.
