SB 2530, SD1 RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE SUPPORT FOR SMALL HTH, CPH

BUSINESS.

Requires group health issuers to offer small group health plans to selfemployed individuals who are licensed by the department of commerce (SSCR2506) and consumer affairs and are located in the group issuer's service areas. **Testimony** Authorizes the insurance commissioner to exempt certain group health

plans based on specified criteria. Allows limits on timing of **Status** enrollment and reenrollment to control adverse selection and plan

costs. (SD1)
