MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR WASTEWATER EEP, FIN HB 2211 PROJECTS. Appropriates funds wastewater projects to comply with federal Environmental Protection Agency standards. RELATING TO DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINERS. EEP, EDB HB 2002 Requires the refund value of a deposit beverage container to be marked directly on the container. RELATING TO THE DEPOSIT BEVERAGE CONTAINER EEP, FIN HB 2235 PROGRAM. Authorizes the use of moneys in the deposit beverage container deposit special fund to acquire real property for redemption centers. RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES. EEP, TRN HB 2330 Requires the department of transportation to adopt rules for the registration of electric vehicles and to issue special license plates for electric vehicles. Waives parking fees, high occupancy vehicle restrictions, and vehicle registration fees for electric vehicles.
