HB 2779 RELATING TO GRAY WATER. EEP, FIN

Requires the department of health to establish a gray water recycling

program.

HB 3444 RELATING TO ENERGY. EEP, FIN

Establishes the energy security special fund and the energy security tax

and appropriates moneys. Effective 7/1/08.

HB 2661 RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO EEP, FIN

ASSIST INDUSTRIAL ENTERPRISES.

Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$38,000,000 to assist Hui Mana 'Oma'o to establish facilities to convert potential renewable energy resources into

electrical energy for public consumption.

HB 2550 RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES. EEP, CPC

Increases the total rated generating capacity produced by eligible customer-generators. Increases the maximum capacity of an eligible customer-generator. Requires the public utilities commission to adopt

rules that incorporate best practices interconnection standards.
