Requires the department of education, in a partnership with the department of health, to establish a three-year food waste recycling pilot project within one or more public schools. Appropriates funds

SB 2932, SD3 (SSCR2856) Status

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSE TAX.

Increases the state environmental response tax on petroleum in order to increase funding available for energy conservation, alternative energy development, global warming initiatives, and other programs pursuant

to chapter 128D, HRS. (SB2932 SD3)

SB 2845, SD2 (SSCR2821) Status

RELATING TO REORGANIZATION OF STATE AGENCIES.

EEP, LMG, FIN

Directs the legislative reference bureau to research the responsibilities of state agencies that are integral to achieving state energy objectives;

identify any duplication or deficiency in the state agencies' responsibilities; research how other states address similar deficiencies

in the administration of their energy policies; and make

recommendations regarding how the state agencies can be reorganized

to advance the long-term energy strategy. (SB2845 SD2)
