RELATING TO MULTI-UNIT RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS.

HSH/HLT, CPC

Requires regular surveys of residents of multi-unit residential buildings on specific needs and issues relating to medical needs, accommodations for the disabled, and other special needs for emergency preparation purposes. Requires multi-unit residential

buildings to have and inform their residents of emergency evacuation plans.

RELATING TO CARE HOME REPAIR AND RENOVATION

LOAN GUARANTEE.

Creates an adult residential care home and long-term care facility repair and renovation loan guarantee office to administer a program to guarantee loans to owners of homes or facilities to be repaired or renovated. Appropriates \$

HB 2581	RELATING TO LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES.  Provides special license plates for motor vehicles registered to long-term care facilities to allow such vehicles to be used to park in handicapped stalls while transporting disabled patients under the facility's care.	HSH/HLT, TRN
<u>HB 3008</u>	RELATING TO QUALIFIED IMPROVEMENT TAX CREDIT. Provides a tax credit for improvements made to federally qualified health centers.	HSH/HLT, FIN
<u>HB 3031</u>	RELATING TO TAXATION.  Establishes an income tax credit for care home operators who make modifications to their home to increase accessibility for their clients.	HSH/HLT, FIN
НВ 3231	RELATING TO HUMAN SERVICES. Requires Med-QUEST and Medicaid coverage for chiropractic care limited to 24 visits per calendar year. Requires department of human services to pass funding on to QUEST plans to implement the services. Appropriates funds.	HSH/HLT, FIN


Testimony submitted will be placed on the Legislative Web site after the hearing adjourns. This public posting of testimony on the Web site should be considered when including personal information in your testimony.
