<u>HB 7, HD1</u> <u>(HSCR1026-08)</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO THE I-SAVERX PRESCRIPTION DRUG PROGRAM. Directs the Governor to establish the State of Hawaii's participation in the I-SaveRx prescription drug program to provide residents with increased access to affordable drugs. (HB7 HD1)	HTH, CPH
<u>HB 466, HD1</u> <u>Proposed SD1</u> <u>(HSCR1041-08)</u> <u>Testimony</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO HEALTH. Proposed SD1: Requires the department of health to submit an annual report on forensic patients; requires yearly court status hearings for individuals ordered to be conditionally released or hospitalized as an inpatient by the mental health court; reduces the minimum length of hospitalization from ninety to thirty days for individuals who are recommitted after conditional release; makes appropriation for mental health court operations.
