temporary appointment, the advice and consent of the nomination of any executive of a principal department or the chairpersons of the

board of agriculture, board of land and natural resources, or Hawaiian

homes commission.

SB 3092 RELATING TO SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER. JDL

<u>Testimony</u>

Stipulates that only the last four digits of an individual's social security number shall be listed on judgments, orders, or decrees endorsed and

Status recorded in the Bureau of Conveyances or Land Court.

SB 3105 RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS. JDL

Testimony

Allows boards and commissions to conduct on-site inspections without public participation if public attendance is impracticable, such as on

<u>Status</u> working farms.

Decision Making to follow, if time permits.
