of interest. Eff. on approval. (SD1)

HB 2034, HD1, SD1 RELATING TO UNATTENDED CHILDREN IN MOTOR TIA, JDL

Testimony VEHICLES.

Makes it a violation of the statewide traffic code to leave a child unattended in a motor vehicle; requires the examiner of drivers to test driver's license applicants for knowledge of this offense; requires

notice of law in rental cars. (SD1)

HB 94, HD1, SD1 RELATING TO INSURANCE. CPH, JDL

Testimony Enacts the Life Settlements Model Act, which establishes consumer

protections in life settlement transactions where the owner of a life insurance policy transfers the death benefit for compensation that is less than the expected death benefit, but more than the surrender value

of the policy. (SD1)

HB 2139, HD2 RELATING TO ANATOMICAL GIFTS. HTH, JDL

Testimony Enacts the Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act. (HB2139 HD2)

HB 2438, HD2, SD1 RELATING TO CIGARETTES. CPH/HTH, JDL

<u>Testimony</u> Establishes a process to ensure that only fire-safe cigarettes are sold in

Hawaii. (SD1)
