SB 2436, SD1 (SSCR2567) Status

RELATING TO CRIME.

JUD

Prohibits a person, with the intent to harass, annoy, or alarm any other person, from making a communication that would: (1) cause the other person to reasonably feel emotional or physical distress; or (2) disrupt the orderly conduct of any institution. Defines communication to include, among other things, by cellular call, electronic mail transmission, or computer. Increases the penalty for harassment to a

misdemeanor. (SB2436 SD1)

SB 2456, SD2

RELATING TO HARASSMENT.

JUD

(SSCR2609) Status

Provides that harassment includes all computer communications; adds computer communication as a form of nonconsensual contact in the

offense of harassment by stalking. Makes such offenses a class C

felony. Eff. 7/1/2050. (SD2)

SB 3182, SD1 (SSCR2884)

RELATING TO EXTENDED SENTENCING.

JUD

Qualifies for extended term sentencing criminal offenders who commit enumerated felonies against good samaritans. Defines good samaritan.

SB 945 (SSCR263) **Status**

RELATING TO ETHICS.

JUD

Extends the requirements of financial disclosures to justices and

judges.
