<u>Testimony</u> Permits the examiner of drivers to also waive the knowledge test for

applicants holding a valid drivers license from another state of the United States, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, American Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada,

or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands. (HB1101

HB 3011, HD1 Testimony	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION. Allows for the greater flexibility in granting special motor vehicle registration. (HB3011 HD1)	TIA, JDL
HB 2034, HD1 Testimony	RELATING TO UNATTENDED CHILDREN IN MOTOR VEHICLES. Makes it a violation of the statewide traffic code to leave a child unattended in a motor vehicle. Effective on approval. Requires the examiner of drivers to test driver's license applicants for knowledge of this offense. Requires notice of law in rental cars. (HB2034 HD1)	TIA, JDL
HB 2953 Testimony	RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides certain vehicle identification exemptions required when shipping a motor vehicle between islands for interisland ferry service providers.	TIA, JDL
HB 3249, HD1 Testimony	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Prohibits parking of motor vehicles on bicycle lanes or bicycle paths. Assesses up to \$500 fine per violation. (HB3249 HD1)	TIA, JDL
HB 2847 Testimony	RELATING TO CONDITIONAL LICENSE PERMITS. Allows conditional license permit for a person's medical needs and caregiving. Clarifies when a conditional license permit is permissible for certain commercial drivers.	TIA
