intra-county ferry service. (SD1)

RELATING TO HARBORS.

TRN/WLH, FIN

(SSCR2760)

Status

Expands the authority of the Aloha Tower development corporation to assist in the development of the statewide harbors modernization plan; authorizes the DOT to issue revenue bonds to finance the harbor

improvements; transfers Hana harbor, excluding its small boat ramp

facility, to DOT. (SB3227 SD2)
