classification.

AUTHORITY.

Requires the Hawaii Community Development Authority to incorporate smart growth principles in community plan rules.

HB 2526

RELATING TO THE STATE PLAN.

WLH

Adds as an objective in the State Plan that land development shall be in

compliance with smart growth principles.
