Imposes administrative fines for damage to stony coral and live rock based on an accepted economic valuation method. (HB3176 HD1)

HB 2687, HD1 RELATING TO AQUATIC RESOURCES. WTL, WAM

Testimony Requires the department of land and natural resources to: review each rule adopted after 01/1/08, concerning the protection and propagation
