**Monday, April 14, 2008**

**H.B. No. 2263, S.D. 1:**

Representative Thielen rose to speak in opposition to the measure, stating:

"Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Speaker, I'm rising to speak against House Bill 2263, Relating to Harbors. The Department of Transportation strongly opposes this bill and I'm going to quote from an email from the DOT:

It is imperative to the public's safety that the Department of Transportation be able to ascertain the weight of all cargo-transporting vehicles that use our State highways and bridges. All of our State bridges have weight limitations. If we are not able to verify the weight of these cargo-transporting vehicles, we will not be able to ensure that these vehicles are safely within the bridges' weight limitation.

In addition, over-weight transport vehicles increase the deterioration of our highways and bridges at a faster rate than non-over-weight vehicles. Consequently, over-weight transport vehicles accelerate the need for repair and maintenance of our highways and bridges. Scaling the vehicles ensures that those over-weight pay for their fair share of the repairs and maintenance costs.

Finally the Department of Transportation is also opposed to Part I of the bill, which deals with harbor noise. Given the ambitious Harbors Modernization Program that our Harbors Division is undertaking, we cannot give a high priority to the promulgation and enforcement of administrative rules to regulate harbor noise.

"Mr. Speaker I would just note that an ambitious Harbors Modernization Program will create noise and that is just part and parcel of what we need to do to modernize our harbors. I think that this bill does not make sense. Thank you."

Representative Rhoads rose to speak in support of the measure, stating:

"On H.B. 2263 in support. Just on the first part of the bill. Currently, the situation is that no one has any regulatory power when noise emanates from the Harbor. I represent an area that borders the main Honolulu Harbor and we understand, those of us who live in Chinatown, understand that it's a working harbor and there's always going to be noise. But not all noise emanating from the Harbor is necessary and that's why this bill is necessary; so that someone can regulate it if need be.

"But having said that, it is a working harbor, it's an industrial harbor, it's the lifeline to our economy and all of us residents down there realize that. Mahalo."

Representative Ward rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for him, and the Chair "so ordered."

Representative Ching rose and asked that the Clerk record an aye vote with reservations for her, and the Chair "so ordered."

The motion was put to vote by the Chair and carried, and the House agreed to the amendments proposed by the Senate to H.B. No. 2263 and H.B.
