On motion by Senator Ige, seconded by Senator Whalen and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and S.B. No. 2417, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HEALTH," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Taxation.

Senator Ige, for the Committee on Health, presented a report (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2064) recommending that S.B. No. 3236, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Taxation.

On motion by Senator Ige, seconded by Senator Whalen and carried, the report of the Committee was adopted and S.B. No. 3236, S.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LIFE SCIENCES," passed Second Reading and was referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Taxation

Senators Ige and Chun Oakland, for the Committee on Health and the Committee on Human Services and Public Housing, presented a joint report of the majority of the Committees (Stand. Com. Rep. No. 2065) recommending that S.B. No. 2101, as amended in S.D. 1, pass Second Reading and be referred jointly to the Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and Affordable Housing and the Committee on Judiciary and Labor.

On motion by Senator Ige, seconded by Senator Whalen and carried, the joint report of the majority of the Committees was adopted and S.B. Senator Baker moved that H.B. No. 2688, H.D. 1, having been read throughout, pass Third Reading, seconded by Senator Tsutsui

Senator Baker rose to speak in favor of the measure and said:

"Madam President, I rise in support of this measure.

"Colleagues, H.B. No. 2688, H.D. 1, provides for the operating expenses of the Legislature and our attached agencies. The passage of this measure is by tradition one of the first actions we take as a Legislative Body once we convene each Session. It's also one of the most critical because it does provide the Legislature with the resources necessary to carry out our responsibilities for the 2008 Legislative Session and the interim that follows. It is a modest measure, Madam President and colleagues, and authorizes \$1.15 million or 3.4 percent less in general funds than the budget we adopted last year. It also includes \$300,000 for the Legislative Reference Bureau to contract with the University of Hawai'i to conduct a study of the state's environmental review process. I think after the interim Session that we had, the Special Session, we would all agree that this is a process that should have been done years ago, and now we will have the resources to do it.

"Madam President and colleagues, I urge all of you to vote 'yes' on this bill. Mahalo."

The motion was put by the Chair and carried, H.B. No. 2688, H.D. 1, entitled: "A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXPENSES OF THE LEGISLATURE, THE AUDITOR, THE LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE BUREAU, AND THE OMBUDSMAN," having been read throughout, passed Third Reading on the following showing of Ayes and Noes:
