The Senate of the Twenty-Fourth Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2008, convened at 11:42 a.m. with the President in the Chair.

The Divine Blessing was invoked by Mr. Kamakana K. Kaimulua, Office of the Honorable Jill N. Tokuda, Hawai'i State Senate, after which the Roll was called showing all Senators present with the exception of Senator Ihara who was excused.

“Madam President, your Committees on Health and Education had held a public hearing on this measure earlier and we request this waiver in order that we may have decision making to make the decking requirements.”

The Chair granted the waiver.

Senator Menor, Chair of the Committee on Energy and Environment, requested a waiver of the notice requirement pursuant to Senate Rule 21 for S.B. No. 3103.

Senator Menor noted:

“Madam President, I think that this bill raises some potentially important issues that we need to consider prior to our decking and crossover deadline.”

The Chair granted the waiver.

ADJOURNMENT

At 11:59 a.m., on motion by Senator Ige, seconded by Senator Whalen and carried, the Senate adjourned until 11:30 a.m., Friday, February 29, 2008.
