HOUSE BILL NO. 2755

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM

Chair Sonson and Members of the Committee:

H.B. 2755 allows Contributory and Noncontributory Plan members who did not make the election to join the Hybrid Plan in 2006 to have another opportunity to switch to the Hybrid Plan.

The ERS' tax attorney informed us that allowing members to have a second choice to join the Hybrid Plan is no longer permissible under the Internal Revenue Code and could jeopardize our tax-exempt status.

However, if the Legislature wishes to allow Contributory and Noncontributory Plan members to join the Hybrid Plan, it must require that <u>all</u> Contributory and Noncontributory Plan members be transferred to the Hybrid Plan. Switching to the Hybrid Plan can no longer be an elective right.

The ERS Board of Trustees has not yet taken a position on this Bill.
