<u>PURPOSE</u>: The purpose of these resolutions is to request the Department of Human Services to study the feasibility of implementing a smoking cessation benefit to Hawaii QUEST beneficiaries.

<u>DEPARTMENT'S POSITION:</u> The Department of Human Services (DHS) supports the intent of these resolutions as the Medicaid QUEST and Medicaid Fee-For-Service programs already provide benefits for smoking dependence such as nicotine patches. In addition, at least two of the four Medicaid QUEST health plans cover smoking cessation counseling to Medicaid clients as an added benefit. The Department is amendable to conducting a feasibility study of developing and implementing a program to provide counseling treatment to all QUEST clients who wish to quit smoking.
