1 Department's Position: The Department strongly sup

The Department strongly supports this Administration bill.

- 2 Fiscal Implications: None
- Purpose and Justification: This measure would allow the Department to establish and fill
- 4 epidemiologist positions, without regard to chapters 76 and 89, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The current
- 5 civil service epidemiological specialist position series is not sufficient for recruiting and retaining staff
- 6 with the technical expertise and multidisciplinary skills necessary to build and maintain the
- 7 Department's capacity for public health surveillance and response. Epidemiologists function at a higher
- 8 level than epidemiological specialists, designing studies to address recurring public health problems
- 9 unique to our environment, collaborating with University colleagues to conduct applied research,
- designing and evaluating health surveillance systems, and synthesizing the results of surveillance,
- investigations, and new scientific developments for use by public health decision-makers.
- Our citizens need highly qualified, experienced epidemiologists to protect the State from new and re-emerging diseases and to interrupt outbreaks rapidly, to minimize their impact on our people and
