
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 260, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
2 amended as follows:
- 3 1. By amending subsection (a) of section 2 to read:
- 4 "(a) There is established the Hawaii anti-trafficking task
5 force. The anti-trafficking task force shall be comprised of
6 the following:
- 7 (1) Individuals:

8 States Conference of Catholic Bishops; and
- 9 (2) Representatives of:
- 10 (A) The immigration information office of the county
11 of Hawaii;
- 12 (B) The crime victim compensation commission;
- 13 (C) The office of the gender equity counselor of the
14 University of Hawaii;
- 15 (D) The Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic
16 Violence;
- 17 ~~(+6)~~ (E) The Salvation Army;
- 18 ~~(+7)~~ ~~Sisters Offering Support;~~
- 19 ~~(+8)~~ (F) The Sex Abuse Treatment Center;

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
8 provided that section 1 shall take effect on June 29, 2008.
