Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 16, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EDUCATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to improve the efficacy of school health functions by:

- (1) Repealing the School Health Services Program currently operating within the Department of Health (DOH);
- (2) Repealing the transfer from DOH to the Department of Education (DOE) of public health nurses who supervise school health aides; and
- (3) Creating a School Health Services Program in DOE.

DOE, DOH, and numerous concerned individuals supported this bill. The Hawaii Government Employees Association and numerous concerned individuals opposed this measure.

Your Committee notes that currently, school principals are not trained in basic first aid or CPR. A suggestion was made to require principals to complete first aid and CPR training to gain an understanding of the clinical aspects of the work that school health aides perform. This training would assist principals in the supervision of school health aides as well as enhance their

ability to contribute to DOE's establishment of a School Health Services Program.
