"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LOSS MITIGATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this bill is to provide incentives for homeowners to protect against the devastation of natural disasters by, among other things:

- Including earthquake resistive devices in the State Loss (1)Mitigation Grant Program (Program);
- (2)Requiring the Insurance Commissioner to develop criteria for earthquake resistive devices;
- Requiring the Insurance Division of the Department of (3)Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA) to develop a loss mitigation public awareness campaign;
- Appropriating funds for a testing facility to test safe (4)room designs and other wind resistant devices;
- (5)Extending the Program for three years; and
- Authorizing the Insurance Commissioner to determine (6)standards for earthquake and wind resistive installation procedures and engineering content.
