Mr. Ogawa is a graduate of McKinley High School and holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in Mathematics and Sociology from the University of Hawaii and a Juris Doctor degree from Indiana University. He has previously served as a public defender and an arbitrator for the Court Annexed Arbitration Program.
