The purpose of this measure is to expand online learning opportunities for students across the State, requiring the Department of Education to implement the recommendations of the Online Learning Task Force.

Testimony in support of the measure was submitted by the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.

Your Committee finds that online learning provides a flexible, alternative learning environment to help meet the needs of all student learners. The expanded use of online technology promises to increase the number of qualified teachers and to better reach our State's rural communities. Your Committee notes that the Department of Education has advised that additional funding is not required to implement the recommendations of the Online Learning Task Force.
