## Madam:

Your Committee on Human Services and Public Housing, to which was referred S.B. No. 1173 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PERINATAL CARE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to continue the pilot perinatal clinic for women with a history of substance abuse on Oahu.

The Department of Human Services submitted testimony in support of the intent of this measure. The University of Hawaii John A. Burns School of Medicine, the Drug Policy Forum of Hawaii, the Hawaii Substance Abuse Coalition, the Hawaii State Commission on the Status of Women, and two individuals submitted testimony in support of this measure.

Your Committee finds that the pilot perinatal clinic provides appropriate health care services to pregnant women who are substance abusers in an effort to help them deliver healthy babies. The pilot perinatal clinic provides substance abuse treatment, prenatal care, and follow-up services in a supportive, rather than punitive, environment. Given the high percentage of drug use among women involved with child welfare services and the criminal justice system, it is important to continue to support the pilot perinatal clinic.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Human Services and Public Housing that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and
