## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[{}] §8-12[}] World Ocean Day. [The first Wednesday of June shall be known and designated as Ocean Day, in recognition 4 5 of the very significant role the ocean plays in the lives of 6 Hawaii's people, as well as Hawaii's culture, history, and 7 traditions. This day is not and shall not be construed as a 8 state holiday.] June 8 of each year shall be known and 9 recognized as "World Ocean Day" to celebrate and honor the 10 oceans of the world, improve international relations, and 11 increase public awareness of conservation management of the 12 ocean environment; provided that this day is not and shall not 13 be construed to be a state holiday. All citizens shall be 14 encouraged to observe and celebrate the blessings of the oceans 15 and endeavor to become caretakers of the ocean for future 16 generations."

- 1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
