ACT 006 S.B. NO. 108

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FAMILY COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 560:5-204, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- $^{"}(d)$ If necessary and on petition or motion and whether or
- 4 not the conditions of subsection (b) have been established, the
- 5 court may appoint a temporary guardian for a minor upon a
- 6 showing that an immediate need exists and that the appointment
- 7 would be in the best interest of the minor. Notice in the
- 8 manner provided in section 560:5-113 shall be given to the
- 9 parents and to a minor who has attained fourteen years of age.
- 10 Except as otherwise ordered by the court, the temporary guardian
- 11 has the authority of an unlimited guardian, but the duration of
- 12 the temporary guardianship shall not exceed [six] twelve months.
- 13 Within five days after the appointment, the temporary guardian
- 14 shall send or deliver a copy of the order to all individuals who
- 15 would be entitled to notice of hearing under section 560:5-205."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
