A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GEOGRAPHIC LIMITATIONS ON TIME SHARES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 514E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "S514E-5 Geographic limitations. Except as provided in
- 4 this section, time share units, time share plans, and transient
- 5 vacation rentals are prohibited.
- 6 (1) Existing time share units, time share plans, and
- 7 transient vacation rentals are not impaired by the
- 8 provisions of this section.
- 9 (2) Time share units, time share plans, and transient
- 10 vacation rentals are allowed:
- (A) In areas designated for hotel use, resort use, or
- 12 transient vacation rentals, pursuant to county
- authority under section 46-4, or where the
- 14 county, by its legislative process, designates
- hotel, transient vacation rental, or resort use;
- 16 (B) In a hotel where the county explicitly approves
- such use, in advance, as a nonconforming use; or

1	(C)	In a county with a population in excess of five
2		hundred thousand, in an existing hotel which is a
3		valid nonconforming use under county ordinance[+
4		provided that the property shall have at least
5		sixty units and at least forty per cent of the
6		units, upon completion of sales of the time share
7		intervals in the project, shall be made available
8	N. Carlotte	for sale as residential apartments or rented as
9		residential apartments]."
10	SECTION 2	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken.	
12	SECTION 3	. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
