### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOL MEALS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The intent of this Act is to modify the manner
- 2 in which school meal prices, including lunch and breakfast, are
- 3 determined. With the rising costs of food, fuel, and labor, the
- 4 department of education requires a better method of determining
- 5 the price of school meals. Currently, the cost of school lunch
- $\mathbf{6}$  is limited to one-half of the cost of preparing the lunch. This
- 7 Act provides the department of education with greater fiscal
- $oldsymbol{8}$  flexibility in the preparation of meals by requiring the
- 9 department of set meal prices at not less than one-half of the
- 10 cost of preparing meals. The Act also defines "school meals".
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 302A-101, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
- 13 and to read as follows:
- ""School meals" means breakfast and lunch prepared and
- 15 served by a school cafeteria."
- 16 SECTION 3. Section 302A-404, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:

1 "[+]\$302A-404[+] School [<del>lunches.</del>] meals. 2 [lunches] meals shall be made available under the school [lunch] meals program in every school where the students are required to 3 4 eat [lunch] meals at school." SECTION 4. Section 302A-405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: The price for [the] school [lunch] meals shall be set 7 "(a) 8 by the department to ensure that moneys received from the sale of the [lunches may] meals shall be not less than [up to] one-9 10 half of the cost of preparing the [school lunch] meals. [price] prices for [the] school [lunch shall] meals may be 11 12 adjusted annually based on the [average cost of preparing the school lunch over the three years preceding any increase; 13 previous year's costs rounded to the nearest five cents; 14 provided that the department by rule shall provide a lower rate 15 16 or free [lunches] meals to children based on their economic need." **17** SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 18

and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
