A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS SEARCH, DEVELOPMENT, AND APPLICATION REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to include
- 2 expenditures for monitoring grant execution, ensuring compliance
- 3 with grant requirements, and auditing grant expenditures in the
- 4 allowable uses of the federal grants search, development, and
- 5 application revolving fund within the department of education.
- 6 This Act also renames the fund to more accurately reflect its
- 7 purpose.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1405, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended to read as follows:
- 10 "[+] §302A-1405[+] Federal grants [search, development, and
- 11 application] revolving fund. (a) There is established a
- 12 federal grants [search, development, and application] revolving
- 13 fund into which shall be deposited the department's share of
- 14 federal indirect overhead reimbursements, pursuant to section
- 15 302A-1404. Unless otherwise provided by law, all other receipts
- 16 shall immediately be deposited to the credit of the general fund
- 17 of the State. The department may expend funds in the federal

- 1 grants [search, development, and application] revolving fund to
- 2 search for discretionary grants [and], develop program
- 3 applications to secure additional revenues for the
- 4 department [-], monitor grant execution, ensure compliance with
- 5 grant requirements, and audit grant expenditures. Moneys in the
- 6 revolving fund may be expended for consultant services and
- 7 operational expenses, including the creation and hiring of
- temporary staff.
- 9 (b) The department shall prepare and submit an annual
- 10 report on the status of the federal grants [search, development,
- 11 and application] revolving fund to the legislature. The annual
- 12 report shall include but not be limited to a list of the grant
- 13 applications to the federal agencies and the grant awards
- id received."
- is SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
