- 2 cases to which the statute applies.
- 3 SECTION 7. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 4 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 5 June 30, 2010, shall lapse.
- 6 SECTION 8. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 7 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 8 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 9 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 10 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 11 of this Act are severable.
- 12 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;
- 13 provided that section 2 shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
