## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARASSMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 711-1106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
3	"(1)	A person commits the offense of harassment if, with
4	intent to	harass, annoy, or alarm any other person, that person:
5	(a)	Strikes, shoves, kicks, or otherwise touches another
6		person in an offensive manner or subjects the other
7		person to offensive physical contact;
8	(b)	Insults, taunts, or challenges another person in a
9		manner likely to provoke an immediate violent response
10		or that would cause the other person to reasonably
11		believe that the actor intends to cause bodily injury
12		to the recipient or another or damage to the property
13		of the recipient or another;
14	(c)	Repeatedly makes telephone calls, facsimile[, or]
15		transmissions, or any form of electronic communication
16		as defined in section 711-1111(2), including
17		electronic mail transmissions, without purpose of
18		legitimate communication;



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1	(d)	Repeatedly makes a communication anonymously or at an
2		extremely inconvenient hour;
3	(e)	Repeatedly makes communications, after being advised
4		by the person to whom the communication is directed
5		that further communication is unwelcome; or
6	(f)	Makes a communication using offensively coarse
7		language that would cause the recipient to reasonably
8		believe that the actor intends to cause bodily injury
9		to the recipient or another or damage to the property
10		of the recipient or another."
11	SECT	ION 2. Section 711-1106.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by	y amending subsection (3) to read as follows:
13	"(3)	For purposes of this section, "nonconsensual contact"
14	means any	contact that occurs without that individual's consent
15	or in disregard of that person's express desire that the contact	
16	be avoide	d or discontinued. Nonconsensual contact includes
17	direct personal visual or oral contact and contact via	
18	telephone	, facsimile, or any form of electronic communication,
19	as define	d in section 711-1111(2), including electronic mail
20	transmiss	ion."

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 2
- 3 begun, before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
