## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NURSE AIDES.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:
1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 226, Session
2	Laws of Hawaii 2007, was enacted to provide for the
3	certification and recertification of nurse aides who work in
4	nursing facilities participating in medicare and medicaid
5	programs and in other state-licensed and state-certified health
6	care settings. Certification is a requirement under 42 United
7	States Code Sections 1395i-3 and 1396r.
8	The purpose of this Act is to specify the renewal period
9	for the recertification of certified nurse aides and the number
10	of continuing education hours required for recertification by
11	the director of human services.
12	SECTION 2. Section 346-46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	"[+]§346-46[+] Certified nurse aides; training programs
15	and recertification. The director shall:

Approve training programs for nurse aides and ensure 16 (1)that the training programs comply with all applicable **17** 18 federal and state requirements;

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1	(2)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
2		for nurse aides who work in medicare or medicaid
3		certified nursing facilities; [and]
4	(3)	Approve and arrange for the recertification process
5		for nurse aides who work in state-licensed or state-
6		certified health care settings [-] ; and
7	(4)	Require recertification not less than every two years.
8		The number of continuing education hours required for
9		recertification shall not exceed twenty-four hours,
10		except as specified by federal law."
11	SECT	ION 3. Section 457A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
12	amended by	y amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
13	"(C)	The director of human services shall implement this
14	chapter in	n accordance with 42 United States Code [sections]
15	Sections :	1395i-3 and 1396r, that relate to:
16	(1)	Training programs for nurse aides and recertification;
17		[and] provided that recertification shall be required
18		not less than every two years and the number of
19		continuing education hours required for
20		recertification shall not exceed twenty-four hours,
21		except as specified by federal law; and

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1	(2) Disciplining of certified nurse aides employed in		
2	health care settings licensed or certified by the		
3	department of human services."		
4	SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that		
5	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were		
6	begun, before its effective date.		
7	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
8	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		

SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
