- 3 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 4 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 5 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 6 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this
- 7 part, as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for
- 8 those cases to which the statute applies.
- 9 SECTION 6. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 10 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 11 June 30, 2010, shall lapse.
- 12 SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 13 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held
- 14 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 15 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 16 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 17 of this Act are severable.
- 18 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
