A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMITTED PERSONS' ACCOUNTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 353-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- "§353-20 Custody of moneys; accounts for committed 3
- persons, etc. All sums collected under this chapter and any 4
- other authorized sources shall be deposited by the department 5
- into [an individual trust account to the credit of the committed 6
- person.] one or more accounts with one or more financial 7
- institutions opened by the department for the specific purpose 8
- of maintaining committed persons' funds. The department shall 9
- 10 maintain [individual ledger accounts for each committed person
- and shall issue to each committed person a quarterly statement 11
- showing credits and debits.] accounts for each committed person 12
- to allow committed persons use of their own funds for approved 13
- 14 expenses and purchases during incarceration. The director may
- designate a percentage of all funds earned by the committed 15
- person while in custody to be deposited and held in a 16
- nonspendable account for the purpose of providing funds for that 17



- 1 same committed person upon release from custody. The structure
- 2 of these accounts shall be designed so that all funds deposited
- 3 by or for a committed person shall be credited to the accounts.
- 4 Accounts maintained by the department for committed persons
- 5 shall not bear interest. No interest of any kind shall be paid
- 6 to a committed person on any account maintained by the
- 7 department for the committed person. The department shall
- 8 provide quarterly accounting statements to all committed persons
- 9 held in custody for over one quarter of the year. The
- 10 department shall conduct annual audits on all committed persons'
- 11 accounts."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to all committed person's
- 13 accounts established before and after the effective date of this
- 14 Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025.

Committed Persons' Accounts

Description:

Amends section 353-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to permit the Director of Public Safety to direct the department to have one or more accounts for committed persons. Also states that the accounts are non-interest bearing and that no interest can be paid to committed persons on the individual accounts. Effective July 1, 2025. (HB1152 HD1)
