## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTALLY-SENSITIVE PRODUCTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to re	ead as follows:	
4	"§321- Environmentally-sensitive cleaning and		
5	maintenan	ce products for use in public schools; guidelines. (a)	
6	The depar	tment of health shall establish guidelines and	
7	specifications for environmentally-sensitive cleaning and		
8	maintenance products for use in public school facilities from		
9	the follo	wing categories:	
10	(1)	Products used to clean hard surfaces in bathrooms such	
11		as counters, walls, floors, fixtures, basins, tubs, or	
12		tile;	
13	(2)	Products used to eliminate dirt and stains on rugs and	
14		<pre>carpeting;</pre>	
15	(3)	Products used for routine cleaning of hard surfaces,	
16		including impervious flooring such as concrete or	
17		tile; provided that this category shall not include:	

1		(A) Products intended primarily to strip, polish, or
2		wax floors; or
3		(B) Cleaners intended primarily for cleaning toilet
4		bowls, dishes, laundry, upholstery, or wood;
5	(4)	Products used to clean glass, windows, mirrors, or
6		metallic or polished surfaces;
7	(5)	Products used for routine, non-specialized hand
8		cleaning;
9	(6)	Paper towels or other paper used for cleaning;
10		provided that this category shall not include toilet
11		paper, facial tissue, or paper towels used for drying
12		hands; and
13	(7)	Other categories as identified in the department of
14		health's guidelines and specifications.
15	(b)	In developing appropriate criteria for the guidelines
16	and speci	fications, the department shall review and evaluate
17	existing	research regarding environmentally-sensitive cleaning
18	and maint	enance products, including any research and guidance
19	issued by	the United States Environmental Protection Agency."
20	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
21	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
