
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER QUALITY.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	DRINKING WATER AND WASTEWATER INFRASTRUCTURE
3	SECTION 1. The purpose of this part is to enable Hawaii to
4	receive and use moneys under the federal American Recovery and
5	Reinvestment Act of 2009 and any later federal laws for drinking
6	water or wastewater infrastructure.
7	SECTION 2. Chapter 340E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
9	and to read as follows:
10	"S340E- Use of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
11	2009 and other federal moneys. (a) The director may provide
12	financial assistance to public water systems for the
13	construction of necessary drinking water infrastructure
14	projects, through the drinking water fund, using moneys from the
15	American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and other
16	applicable federal acts.
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11	(b) The director may establish a separate account within

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1	moneys appropriated under federal laws that authorize principal				
2	forgiveness, zero and negative interest loans, and grants,				
3	including without limitation the American Recovery and				
4	Reinvestment Act of 2009 and other applicable federal acts. The				
5	director may use those moneys and in so doing may include				
6	additional requirements and subsidization not applicable to the				
7	remainder of the drinking water fund, including forgiveness of				
8	principal, zero and negative interest loans, and grants to				
9	public water systems that meet eligibility requirements for the				
10	drinking water fund.				
11	(c) The director shall certify that a project is entitled				
12	to priority over other eligible projects on the basis of

4	SECTION 3. Chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
5	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated			
6	and to read as follows:			
7	"§342D- Use of American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of			
8	2009 and other federal moneys. (a) The director may provide			
9	financial assistance for publicly owned wastewater treatment			
10	works for the construction of necessary wastewater			
11	infrastructure projects, through the revolving fund, using			
12	moneys from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009			
13	and other applicable federal acts.			
14	(b) The director may establish a separate account within			
15	the revolving fund and assign to that account federal moneys			
16	appropriated under federal laws that authorize principal			
17	forgiveness, zero and negative interest loans, and grants,			
18	including without limitation the American Recovery and			
19	Reinvestment Act of 2009 and other applicable federal acts. The			
20	director may use those moneys and in so doing may include			
21	additional requirements and subsidization not applicable to the			
22	remainder of the revolving fund, including forgiveness of			
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1	principal, zero and negative interest loans, and grants to				
2	publicly-owned wastewater treatment works that meet eligibility				
3	requirements for the revolving fund.				
4	(c) The director shall certify that a project receiving				
5	financial assistance is entitled to priority over other eligible				
6	projects on the basis of water pollution and financial needs as				
7	well as a preference to those projects that can be started and				
8	completed expeditiously as stipulated under the American				
9	Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and other applicable				
10	federal acts.				
11	(d) Among eligible projects, the director may also give				
12	priority to projects that incorporate renewable energy, energy				
13	efficiency, and conservation measures in wastewater				
14	infrastructure, to the extent allowed by federal law.				
15	(e) Each project receiving financial assistance shall be				
16	in conformance with the conditions for water pollution control				
17	financing under section 342D-87(a) (1), (2), (4) and (5) and				
18	<u>(b).</u> "				
19	SECTION 4. Section 340E-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
20	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted				
21	and to read as follows:				

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1	" <u>"American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009" means the</u>				
2	federal law, P.L. 111-5, making appropriations for various				
3	purposes, including job preservation and creation,				
4	infrastructure investment, energy efficiency and science,				
5	assistance to the unemployed, and state and local fiscal				
6	stabilization purposes."				
7	SECTION 5. Section 342D-80, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
8	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted				
9	and to read as follows:				
10	""American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009" means the				
11	federal law, P.L. 111-5, making appropriations for various				
12	purposes, including job preservation and creation,				
13	infrastructure investment, energy efficiency and science,				
14	assistance to the unemployed, and state and local fiscal				
15	stabilization purposes."

17	TOTAL MAXIMUM LOAD COORDINATOR				
18	SECTION 6. Chapter 342D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
19	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
20	and to read as follows:				
21	"§342D- Total maximum daily load coordinator. The				
22	department may establish not more than two exempt positions,				
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1	each entitled "total maximum daily load coordinator". The total			
2	maximum daily load coordinator positions shall, among other			
3	duties, assist the department to meet federal requirements for			
4	establishing total maximum daily loads in Hawaii. This includes			
5	quantifying waste load allocations and load allocation limits on			
6	pollutant loading of Hawaii inland and marine waters and			
7	developing technically based plans for achieving the State's			
8	stated water quality goals. The positions shall be appointed by			
9	the director without regard to chapter 76. These positions			
10	shall be funded by federal grants to the State under the Federal			
11	Water Pollution Control Act of 1972, P.L. 92-500 (33 U.S.C.			
12	<u>§§1251-1387), as amended.</u> "
