A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ease the 2 interisland transportation of rental motor vehicles. Tourists, from time to time, are frustrated and, on occasion, cancel their 3 plans to take their rental vehicle to a neighbor island by 4 5 interisland ferry due to lost or misplaced documents relating to 6 their rental motor vehicle. The passage of this Act will 7 significantly reduce these problems by reducing current 8 restrictions for such documents as they apply to rental motor 9 vehicles. 10 SECTION 2. Section 286-271, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 11 12 "(e) This section shall not apply to: 13 Any motor vehicle rental company as defined in section (1)14 431:9A-141 that periodically ships in quantities of 15 ten vehicles or more; Licensed dealers who periodically ship in quantities 16 (2) 17 of ten vehicles or more, or whose primary business is
