A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to ease the 1 interisland transportation of rental motor vehicles. 2 Tourists, from time to time, become frustrated and cancel their plans to 3 take their rental vehicle to a neighbor island by interisland 4 5 water carrier due to lost or misplaced documents relating to 6 their rental motor vehicle. The passage of this Act will 7 significantly reduce these problems by reducing current 8 restrictions for such documents as they apply to rental motor 9 vehicles. SECTION 2. Section 286-271, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 11 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: "(e) This section shall not apply to: 12 13 Any motor vehicle rental company as defined in section (1)431:9A-141 that periodically ships in quantities of 14 15 ten vehicles or more; 16 (2) Licensed dealers who periodically ship in quantities of ten vehicles or more, or whose primary business is 17
