A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AN EXEMPTION TO THE RENTAL VEHICLE AND TOUR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the seemingly global
- 2 recession has dampened tourism numbers, leading to a strain on
- 3 our local economy. It has also forced residents to scale back
- 4 on their travel plans. For those that were set on travelling
- 5 off island, economic reality may force residents to travel in-
- 6 state.
- 7 Tourism-based businesses, such as rental car companies,
- 8 would welcome this kind of choice by residents, as it would
- 9 contribute much needed revenue into their businesses, allowing
- 10 them to keep employees working. The rental motor vehicle
- 11 surcharge tax, however, increases the price of a rental car,
- 12 making inter-island getaways that much more expensive for
- 13 residents.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to exempt residents from the
- 15 rental motor vehicle surcharge tax.

2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§251-A</u> <u>Exemption; residents.</u> Residents of the state
5	shall be exempt from the tax imposed by section 251-2(a). A
6	state identification card or state drivers license listing an
7	in-state address shall be sufficient proof of residency for
8	purposes of this exemption."
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
